Mr. Brewer will talk about some of the area's family plots, differences between granite and marble stones, religious history and background of the cemetery, along with marker (gravestone) trends being utilized today. Each type is somewhere in our cemetery, including old stones with poetry, 1920's stones with classic art, and children's stones with animals. He will also touch on the history of the transferred grave sites from the Great Sacandaga area which were relocated during the construction of the Conklingville Dam. A Power Point presentation will also accompany Mr. Brewer's talk.
